**HOUSEHOLD FILES DECLARATORY ACTION
AGAINST DECISIONING.COM'S PATENTS**

Columbia, South Carolina, November 28, 2003 – Affinity Technology Group, Inc. [OTCBB: AFFI] today announced that Household International, Inc. has filed a declaratory judgment action against Affinity's patent licensing subsidiary, decisioning.com, Inc., in United States District Court in Wilmington, Delaware. In its complaint, Household requests the court to rule that Household is not infringing upon any of decisioning.com's patents and that these patents are not valid.

Joe Boyle, Affinity's President and Chief Executive Officer, said, "Household's decision to bring this action follows our efforts to license certain of our patents to Household. We regret that we were unable to reach a mutually satisfactory agreement with Household. We are currently evaluating whether to pursue this action in Delaware or to challenge Household's decision to file this action in Delaware. However, if necessary, we stand ready to present our case against Household."

Through its subsidiary, decisioning.com, Inc., Affinity Technology Group, Inc., owns a portfolio of patents that cover the automated processing and establishment of loans, financial accounts and credit accounts through an applicant-directed remote interface, such as a personal computer or terminal touch screen. Affinity's patent portfolio includes U. S. Patent No. 5,870,721C1, No. 5,940,811, and No. 6,105,007.
